- 1 pencil box (*can be found at Dollar Tree, Target, Staples, etc.*) filled with the following:
(1 box of crayons, colored pencils, kids scissors, 1 glue stick, 1 dry erase marker, 2 pencils)
- 2 boxes of 24 pack Crayola Crayons
- 1 pack of 12 Crayola colored pencils
- 1 pair of kids safe scissors
- 5 glue sticks (.77 ounce size – large one- ELMER's brand only
Disappearing Purple preferred)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 oversized t-shirt for a smock (labeled with name in collar in Sharpie)
- 1 coloring book
- 2 thin black dry erase markers (have two at home as well)
- 5 Ticonderoga #2 pencils **sharpened**
- 1 clipboard
- 2 containers of Play Doh (3 oz. containers)
- 1 pair of headphones (NOT EARBUDS) placed in Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name on the outside of the bag

The last two supplies are not required but would be appreciated:

- 1 container of sanitizing wipes (ex. Lysol, Wet Wipes or Clorox)
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

Put the extra supplies (crayons, glue, pencils and dry erase marker) that are not in the pencil box into a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name on it. This Ziploc Bag along with their smock, clipboard, Play Doh, tissues, coloring book and headphones can be placed into a shopping bag with your child's name. We plan to set up a supply drop off day for you before the start of school.

- Last names that start with M-Z, please bring 2 containers of antibacterial wipes (no name)

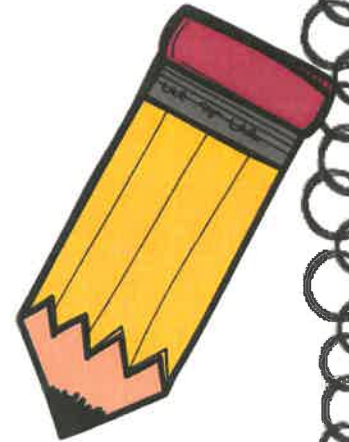
