

# **MEDICATION PROTOCOL**

No student is to carry medication to the classroom. If it is necessary that medication be taken during school hours, the following is required:

1. A Medication Authorization Form, Asthma Action Plan and/or Allergy Emergency Treatment form completed by the primary care provider
2. A Medication Authorization Form completed by a parent
3. Medication is to be in the correct prescription bottle, labeled with the name of the child, current dosage, date of prescription, prescription number, and name of prescribing primary care provider
4. Please keep in mind when sending in medication, only the nurse is permitted to dispense medication according to New Jersey State Law
5. Non Prescription medications (i.e. Aspirin, Tylenol, Cough drops, Cough syrup, etc.) may only be administered when a Medication Authorization Form is completed by the primary care provider and a parent. These medications must come in the original container.
6. No parent's or primary care provider's phone instructions can be accepted.
