## Community

Montville Township, is a suburban community of 22,450 in Morris County, New Jersey, that is located 34 miles from New York City. In 2022, the ranking and review website *Niche.com* named Montville #10 for "Best Place to Live in Morris County," and ranked it at #81 out of 647 places to live in New Jersey.

## District

Montville Township Public Schools, a Pre-K to 12 district, placed at #34 out of 243 of the "Best School Districts in New Jersey" and #4 out of 18 of the "Best School Districts in Morris County" by *Niche.com* for its 2023 rankings. The district has been nationally recognized by the NAMM Foundation as a Best Community for Music Education for 7 years in a row. The district was also named a National District of Character in 2018, by *Character.org*, and 6 district schools have been named National Schools of Character. One district elementary school is also a National Blue Ribbon School. All 7 district schools were recertified in 2020 at the Bronze Award level by Sustainable Jersey.

## School

Montville Township High School is a comprehensive, four-year public school with a current enrollment of 278 seniors out of 1105 students. Montville Township High School values its 10:1 student-teacher ratio. The majority of the faculty holds at least one advanced degree. Montville Township High School offers over 39 extracurricular activities in addition to 27 varsity athletic teams. The vast majority of our students are actively engaged in our school and broader community.

In 2022, Montville Township High School ranked #87 in New Jersey High Schools by *U.S. News and World Report* and won the College Success Award from *GreatSchools.org* for the fourth consecutive year. Additionally, Montville Township High School ranked #81 out of 425 for "Best Public High Schools in New Jersey," and #12 out of 24 for "Best Public High Schools in Morris County," for 2023, by *Niche.com*. In 2022, the National Speech and Debate Association included Montville Township High School on its list of the Top 300 Schools in the USA. Montville Township High School also achieved Bronze Opportunity School status from CyberStart America.

## Curriculum Highlights

MTHS offers over 175 courses that include:

- 23 Advanced Placement classes in both core academic subjects and the arts, and a rigorous Honors program offering 33 classes;
- 9 Middle College classes where students earn college credit;
- An Independent Study Program; and
- Electives in the Visual/Performing Arts, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Technology, Life/Career Skills, and Financial Literacy.
- The 3-year Science Research Program, offers sophomore students the opportunity to participate in self-selected, authentic research in natural or social science. Each summer, students participate in an internship project with a mentor from a professional research institution.
- Nationally recognized by *District Administration*, the Humanities Research Program engages students in the process of combining student conducted research with end-product creation and leadership development.

## Student Achievements

### Academic

- 1 National Merit Scholar, 11 National Merit Finalists, 11 Semi-Finalists, 64 Commended Students, and 2 students received the National Merit Corporate Scholarship over the last 3 years.
- 37 students were awarded AP Scholar with Distinction, 24 awarded AP Scholar with Honor, and 44 awarded AP Scholar.
- In 2022, 22 students earned the Seal of Biliteracy. Two students earned it by mastering two languages in addition to English.

### Extracurricular

- The Forensics team was ranked among the top 1% in schools nationwide. They enjoyed continued success at multiple national tournaments in 2022, including students qualifying and placing for the National Speech and Debate Tournament in 7 categories. The team also placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the State of New Jersey.
- Six student projects (5 papers and 1 website) qualified for the NJ History Day competition through William Paterson University.
- One student was selected for the Junior Region Band and one student was selected for the violin section of North Jersey Region Orchestra through competitive auditions.
- The Marching band was highly rated in the Tournament of Band Competitions.
- Three students were selected for the Fresh Perspectives Exhibition at The Morris Museum. Only 50 students are selected from a group that can include every high school in the state.
- Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA): 12 students qualified for, and competed in the National Leadership Conference in Chicago in a variety of events.

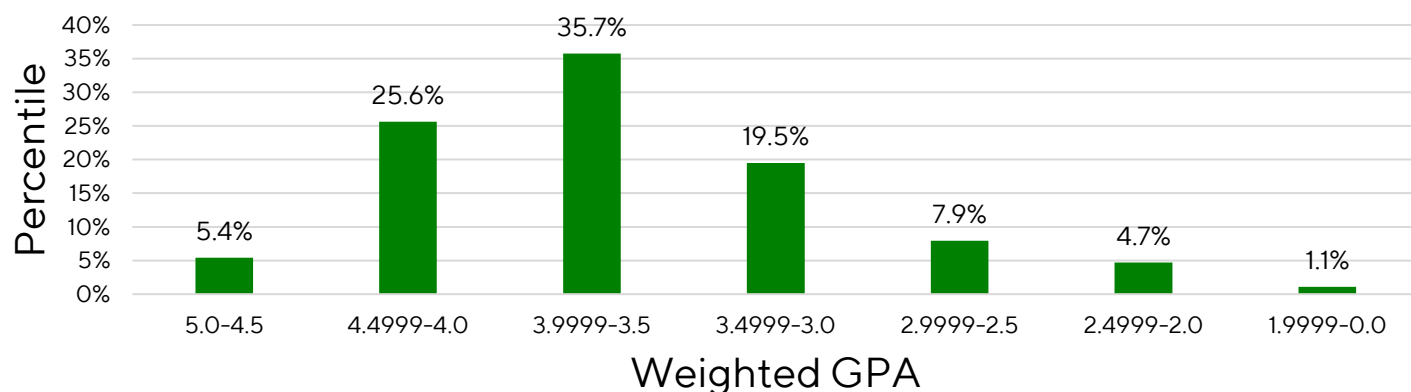
